



Who can stay and play?

We offer 2- hour limit per visit, with a maximum of 3 hours per day, per child **FREE**. Children must be on a family membership for free nursery. **After the time limit has been reached, nursery rates apply.**

Member: \$5.00 per hour per child. Community \$6.00 per hour per child. We do not prorate. Hourly fees also apply for late pickup.

The room is designed for children under 6 years old. Children 6 years old and older are encouraged to participate in our fun, FREE kids activities. See schedule for details. If they are checked into the nursery, they must adhere to the same check in policies and behavior guidelines as above. Children are not allowed to sit outside the fitness studios waiting for their parents.

SICK

Sick children are not permitted inside the Jungle Gym Nursery. If a child seems to become ill during their visit the parent will be asked to come pick them up.

Child Security

Parents and their children must have a current photo taken before utilizing the Jungle Gym Nursery. Only parents and guardians who are on the account may drop off and pick up children from the Jungle Gym Nursery

Outside workouts

Parents may not drop off children and leave the premises unless involved in an "outside" workout. If you are leaving the Club for a workout please leave an alternative contact number or cell phone number with our staff.

What to wear

When checking in a child please remove their shoes and put on non-slip socks which members provide.

No food

Check-In and Check-Out

1. Scan your child's membership card when checking in and out of the Nursery. The nursery staff will put a label on your child.
2. Hang up your child's belongings
3. Assist them with their shoes & socks.

Diapers

Please provide your own diapers. **If we use a club diaper there is a charge of \$3.00.** It's always a good idea to bring a change of clothes in case your child has a potty accident.

Security

Do not leave your personal items in the Jungle Gym Nursery. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Behavior

1. Verbal reprimand
2. Sit in a chair for a period of time (typically 1 minute for every age of the child)
3. A discussion with the parent to work towards better behavior.
4. Conference with the parents (first warning).
5. If the child's behavior continues we may ask that your child takes a break from the nursery.
